VETERANS HORSEMANSHIP PROGRAM

Carlos has completed our Foundation Horsemanship Course and is now sharing our mission in the veterans' community. He believes other veterans will benefit from our unique approach to bringing horses and people together.



Interested in learning more about our Veterans Program?

Our Foundation Course offers an introduction to basic horse handling and interactions in a safe and positive manner. Participants complete 6-8 hours of learning over several visits, gaining knowledge and confidence through their experience. Upon completing the course, they may choose to continue their learning of advanced horsemanship skills, horse care and wellness practices. We also offer one-time individual and family visits for

those looking to spend time in nature and with animals in a peaceful environment.

What makes our program unique?

We offer a recreational horsemanship program with therapeutic benefits. Participants learn how to create a safe and beneficial experience for themselves and their equine partner. Self-awareness, regulation, critical thinking, compassion, and communication are all key components of Partnership-Based Horsemanship.
